

Woodblock Prints
Chen Qi



The Chen Qi woodblock exhibition appearing at both the Glasgow Print Studio and the Ricefield Arts and Cultural Centre from 23 May - 28 June 2008 and also at the Oriental Museum Durham University from 26 January – 20 April 2008 brings a number of remarkable prints to Glasgow and Durham as part of CHINA NOW, the UK's largest ever festival of Chinese culture.

Collaborating with Ricefield Arts and Cultural Centre, the prints on exhibition are substantial two-metre square woodblock prints. Each of the works is made with unique delicacy and outstanding ingenuity employing traditional printmaking techniques to create works monumental in size. During this exhibition the artist will hold a master class in Chinese woodblock printmaking.

Chen Qi is a Professor of Fine Art at Beijing University who has exhibited extensively throughout the world. Most recently, Qi exhibited his ten metre high monumental woodblock prints at the British Library.
